

A Statement Issued via Barony of Madrone Distribution List Regarding King County Policy on Events and Proof of Vaccination – October 25, 2021

Unto the populace of Madrone ,

Starting Oct. 25, 2021, a verification of vaccination or negative COVID-19 test will be required by Public Health — Seattle & King County to participate in activities, events, fitness programs or other gatherings.

For the barony, this includes, but is not limited to, fighter practice at Kapka, guild meetings, and any events. (Yes, unless the rules change, this will include Twelfth Night.)

Individuals 12 and older must show proof of being fully vaccinated. "Fully vaccinated" means that a person has received all the required doses of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine (two doses of the Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech vaccines, or one dose of the Johnson & Johnson vaccine) and 14 days have passed since the final dose. Children 11 and younger are allowed to enter these facilities without verification of vaccination or negative test.

Verification may be established by any of the following methods of documentation:

- CDC COVID-19 Vaccine Record Card
- Photo of CDC Vaccine Record Card
- QR Code, digital or printed certificate from [MyLRmobile.com](https://mylrmobile.com) (WA Department of Health partner website, My Immunization Records)
- Vaccine administration record from a vaccine provider, including an individual's doctor, pharmacy or other official immunization record from within or outside the U.S., including a photo or photocopy

Individuals who are not fully vaccinated can enter these facilities by providing a digital or printed documentation from a testing agent, including a laboratory, health care provider or pharmacy, of a negative FDA-approved PCR test administered within the previous 72 hours. Home COVID-19 rapid self-test kit results are not accepted.

Reminder that per SCA policy, "Any person challenging the event staff regarding the enforcement of this COVID policy shall be denied entry to or immediately removed from the activity." See antir.org for details.

Proof will not be recorded or kept. You will need to provide this proof for every time you attend an event or activity.
